# A MESSAGE FROM THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER

"A society grows great when old men plant trees under the shade of which they will never sit." — Greek Proverb



Efforts to promote and protect the health and wellbeing of residents in Darke County have been ongoing for over one-hundred years. Throughout this time period, a procession of individuals working collectively to improve public health proverbially planted trees under the shade of which they would never sit. From organizing health boards in the early twentieth century to combat typhoid and tuberculosis, improve sanitation, and impact maternal and infant health, to addressing modern day epidemics, environmental health concerns, and social determinants of health in 2023 under the auspices of the Darke County General Health District, improving public health has always required collaborative effort by individuals willing to work toward health strategies the success of which may not be realized until generations later.

An article titled Health Board is Organized published in The Greenville Democrat on Wednesday, March 9th, 1910, gave formal notice to the public that Greenville's new health board, led by board president D.E. Horn, had made the following appointments: Dr. S.A. Hawes as Health Officer, Ben Devor as Sanitary Policeman, and John P. Lucas as Plumbing Inspector. In 1915, the same paper announced the hiring of Miss Jessie Chapman, of Columbus, as Greenville's Public Health Nurse. In 1926, the Darke County Health Unit was formed by the Boards of Health of Darke County and the city of Greenville, with Dr. M.E. Barnes from Montgomery, Alabama taking charge as Health Officer. By 1930, the Department of Health represented the combined interests of the city of Greenville and Darke County, setting the precedent for the current operation of the health department to this day. Although these early efforts to create local systems through which public health could be improved yielded immediate, successful results, long-term public health victories require unceasing, day-to-day provision of public health foundational services to ensure gains spanning generations are not lost.

The early historical beginnings of the Darke County General Health District prove that while institutions dedicated to public health, and the individuals within them, inevitably change over time, one unending constant is the willingness to invest in public health as a community for the benefit of future generations. In 2023, we continued this tradition of doing today what impacts tomorrow by working to improve childhood vaccination rates, ensuring our environment and the places we congregate are safe, and providing health education. In short, we continue planting trees to shade the next generation.














